How FULLOUT handles your information

Who we are. FULLOUT ('we', 'us') is the dance programme run by Taylor Yates, based in South East London. For data-protection purposes the data controller is Taylor Yates, contactable at hello@fullout.uk.

The information we collect

- **When you apply:** your name, date of birth, contact details, dance background, social media handle, and the video and information you submit.
- **If you are offered a place:** enrolment details including emergency contacts, relevant medical information, payment details, and photography/video consent.
- **Images and footage:** photographs and video captured during sessions and shoots.

Why we use it

We use your information to assess applications, run the programme, keep students safe, take payment, and communicate with you and (for under-18s) your parent or carer. Our lawful bases are: performing our agreement with you; our legitimate interests in running and promoting the programme; consent (for example for photography, which you can withdraw); and legal obligations around safeguarding and health and safety.

Under-18s

Most of our students are under 18. Where a student is under 18, we obtain consent from a parent or carer for enrolment, medical information, and photography and video use. Parents and carers can contact us at any time to review or withdraw consent.

Who we share it with

We do not sell your information. We share it only where necessary: with the providers who help us run the programme (for example our application form and payment providers), and with the relevant authorities where we are required to protect a child or comply with the law. Released videos are published under the consent you have given.

Images and footage

Creating and releasing visuals is part of FULLOUT. We film sessions and shoots and publish released projects and clips, including on our social media. We only do this with consent, which for under-18s is given by a parent or carer, is renewed each year, and can be withdrawn. Withdrawing consent does not affect material already published, but we will not use it in new material.

How long we keep it

We keep unsuccessful applicants' data for a short period and then delete it. We keep student records for the duration of enrolment and a reasonable period afterwards for safeguarding, insurance and legal purposes, then securely delete them.

Your rights

You can ask to see the information we hold about you, ask us to correct or delete it, object to or restrict certain uses, and withdraw consent where we rely on it. To do any of these, contact us at hello@fullout.uk.
